Philipse Manor Hall State Historic Site is housed in the Manor Hall of the Philipse family. Built in the 1680s, the Hall was used by four generations of the Philipse family. After Frederick Philipse III and his family escaped to England as Loyalists following the American Revolution, the Hall was owned by several individuals before becoming the Yonkers Village Hall and later Yonkers City Hall. Today, Philipse Manor Hall State Historic Site is one of over 200 parks and historic sites operated by the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation. Exhibits incorporate the journeys of the Philipse family, the Indigenous people from whom the Philipse lands derive, and enslaved Africans, from whose work and trade the Philipse family prospered during the pre-Revolutionary era. While past exhibits and lectures have documented the role that Africans and Indigenous people contributed to New York State history, these expanded permanent exhibits more fully depict the multicultural environment of the colonial period, and share this complex history with visitors.

Glenview, built in 1876, is an example of American Aesthetic design, also known as Arts and Crafts. Restored rooms feature stenciling, carved woodwork, and ceramic tiles as well as furniture designed by Philadelphia cabinetmaker Daniel Pabst, period settings, fine china, paintings, and sculpture.

The trail follows the Putnam Trailway north from there, winding through wooded areas, past scenic lakes, and through small communities. The trail passes through Carmel, and ends slightly west of the Village of Brewster, at the intersection of Carmel Ave (Route 6) and Putnam Ave. There are several designated parking areas along this 9-mile section. Although there are no services directly on the trail, a variety of local businesses can be accessed short distances off the route.

Built in 1700, the stone and brick house was owned by Patriot Johannes DeWint during the Revolution and is the oldest surviving building in Rockland County. Commander in Chief George Washington was a guest in the south parlor twice in 1780, as well as in 1783. While there in the fall of 1780, he signed the death warrant of British Major John Andre, who was involved with Benedict Arnold in the plot to surrender West Point to the enemy. During his stay in 1783, Washington entertained British General Sir Guy Carleton to negotiate the vanquished army's evacuation of New York City. Today, the house's two first-floor rooms have been restored and furnished to reflect the period of Washington's occupancy. An adjacent 19th-century carriage house contains displays of artifacts uncovered at the site during archaeological digs, as well as items related to Washington, André, and Arnold.
